Geneva: The Laws of Armed Conflict

Monday 5th and Tuesday 6th July 2021 (Running Indian Time - 2:30pm - 8:30pm Lunch break 5:30 - 6:30pm)

You will learn about how armed conflict is prevented and (when it does occur) how it is regulated. You will understand how the prohibition of war came about, the institutions that exist to preserve peace, and present-day legal issues in regulating armed conflict. You will also learn about the rules that apply in armed conflict situations - for instance, understanding when the "laws of armed conflict" apply and how they protect civilians in the theatre of war.
